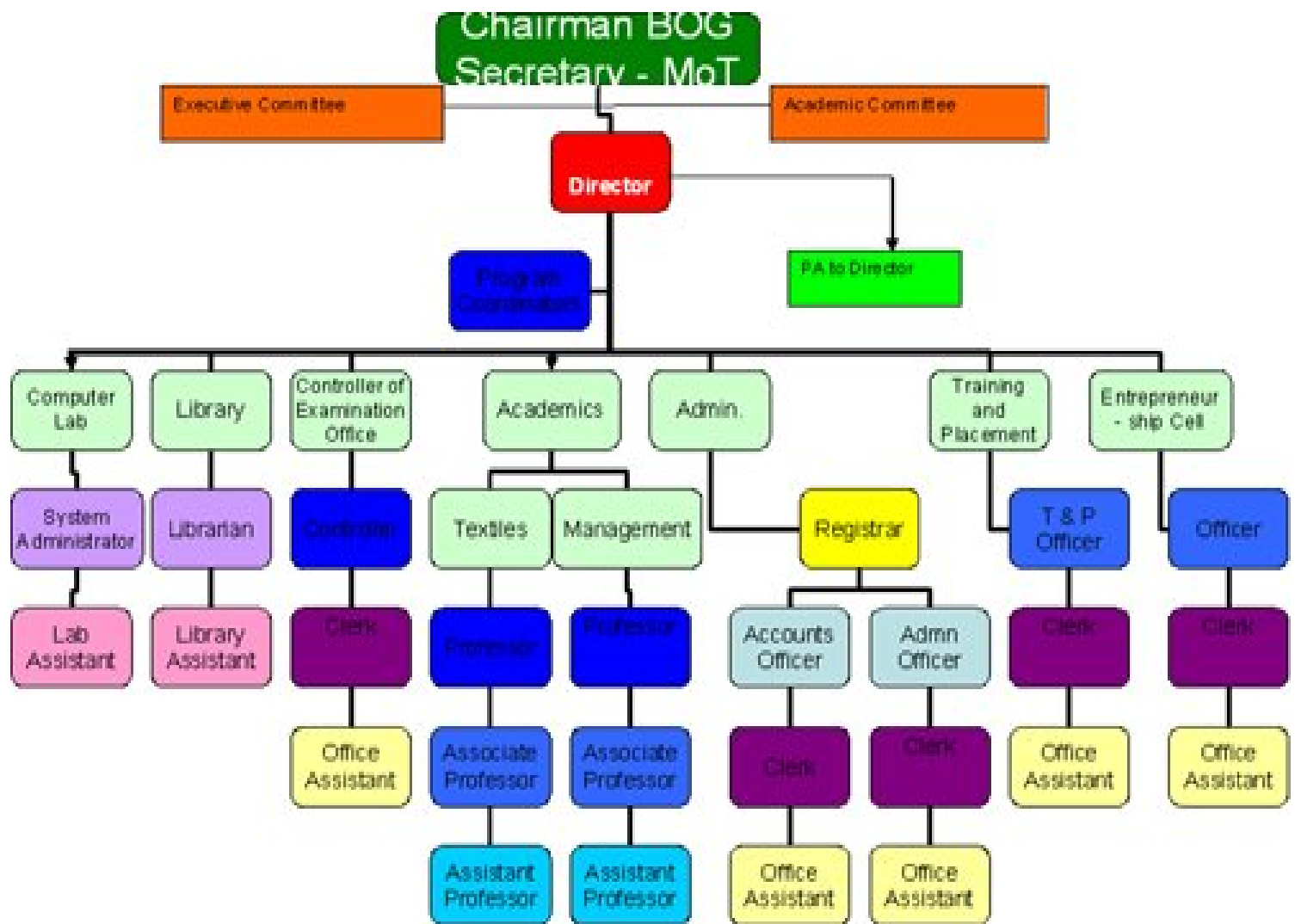

IV. PROGRAMMES CONDUCTED

a. Post-Graduate Diploma in Management - (PGDM) Textiles

Seats : 40

Course Duration : 4 semesters (Approx. 90 working days per semester)

Fee : Rs.35,000/- per semester

Placement Facility : Available and assistance provided

The two year full time course (PGDM) – Textiles is designed to offer core management learning for textile professionals. Addressing the growing complexity and competition of textile business, this program provides the right synergy of technology and management aligned to the specific needs of textiles industry. The course runs through four semesters. The first two semesters comprise of fundamental management training with specific application in

textiles industry. This is complemented with industrial interaction, seminars, projects etc. to develop and enhance the latent skills of the students. A summer project between the second and third semester provides needed practical exposure to industry and its functioning. The third semester takes the students through the advanced areas of textiles industry management. In the fourth and final semester students specialize in the functional areas and conduct an extensive industry based project. This provides thorough knowledge and understanding in specific domain.

b. Post-Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM) - Apparel

Seats : 40

Course Duration : 4 semesters (Approx. 90 working days per semester)

Fee : Rs.35,000/- per semester

Placement Facility : Available and assistance provided

The two-year full time course (PGDAM) is oriented to the needs of fast growing apparel industry covering knitting and garment clusters in the country. Creating a cadre of specialized professionals with technical and managerial knowledge is the gist of this course. The course is divided into four semesters. The first semester deals with basic textiles, knitting technology and fundamentals of management. The second semester comprised of an advanced study of apparel, marketing, finance aspects of management interspersed with industry project. The third semester deals with study of Apparel Production Technology, Quality Control and Textiles, Management Information System, International Marketing and Entrepreneurship Development with two electives of their choice. The fourth semester, the students specializes in their field of interest like HR, Marketing, Production, IT and Fashion Management apart from two core courses on finishing in garment and textile costing. This provides a comprehensive knowledge of theoretical and practical facets of the apparel Industry.

IX. INFORMATION ON INFRASTRUCTURE AND OTHER RESOURCES AVAILABLE

The Institute is situated in a 6.5 acres campus with administrative and academic blocks. The Administrative Block is housed in the main building comprises the library and seminar hall with overtones of colonial architecture enclosing an area of 10,500 Sq.ft. A two storied academic block of 2,300 Sq.ft. housing the class rooms has been donated by Tirupur Exporters' Association (TEA), Southern India Mills' Association (SIMA) and Powerloom Development and Export Promotion Council (PDEXCIL). The Institute is in the construction face of state of art Academic block and Auditorium (50,000 sq.ft.) emerging as a landmark in the city.

The Institute is in the process of building up adequate infrastructure with large and spacious class rooms, air-conditioned seminar halls, besides recreation facilities like indoor games etc. for the students.

LIBRARY AND INFORMATION CENTRE

The Institute has a well-equipped library with a large collection of books on textile and management oriented subjects. WEBOPAC facility is available for browsing all the database of the library. Excluding books, the library is also having a collection of Audio/Video Cassettes, CDROM, Conference proceedings, Project Reports etc. The Institute also subscribes EBSCO and Capitaline database for the enhancement of the students. The Library & Information Center of SVPITM came into existence from the inception of the Institute. Since this is svpitmthe only textile Institute which provides Management Studies under Textile field, the Library and Information Center serves the faculty, staff and the students with world-class information related to textile and management studies with good collection of Books, Journals, CD-ROMs, Online resources etc. To enhance the user satisfaction the Library adopts LIBSYS software in library automation with quality professionals to serve the users.

Rules and Regulations for students

1. While entering the computer laboratory, one must make an entry in the log book *.
2. Always login in a system with proper id and password. Choose the password for your network computer user account which is not "guessable." Make it a combination of letters and numbers or special characters.
3. In case of lost password for network access or to change password, contact the network administrator.
4. Store contents in the work area provided for you in the server for easy access from any system.
5. You can back up your data regularly in the additional drives available in the local machine itself.
6. Use of any media (Floppy / CD / DVD / Pen Drive) or transfer of files from digital camera or any storage media to the network storage is subject to permission from the network administrator only.
7. No user is allowed to login a computer as administrator. He/She is only an ordinary user with assigned individual / group user-id.
8. Inform and seek permission from the IT department (recommended procedure) while transferring/shifting devices (such as desktop computers, laptops) from one place to other inside the campus for any task.
9. In case of any requirement in taking laptops / projectors or any devices outside the campus, acquire a gate pass from the administration office.
10. Do not try getting other's data from the computer or the network.
11. Taking a photograph using any media in the laboratory is prohibited.
12. Do not login with other's login-id or do not lend your login id and password to others. Any data loss thereby may not be retrieved.
13. Log off / shut down your computer* when you leave your desk and leave the laboratory furniture in place and position.*
14. The students have to send a request to the IT department for any hard copy print by listing the file, location and page numbers of the content for print and collect only during the break hours. Users have to enter in the log book and collect the print out. This procedure applies to copying / writing data in CDs also.
